This team worked towards creating awareness about the importance of having green surroundings. They performed a combination of activities such as organizing a lake cleaning drive, collaborating with external organizations, planting saplings, and designing a “Green Wall” at their school to spread awareness.

Project Objectives:

- Spreading awareness about the need for green surroundings
- Cleaning up one of the most polluted lakes in the city
- Collaborating with other organizations so they can create impact at a larger scale

Activities:

- Collected funds through recycling old newspapers and PET bottles
- Organized clean-up of the Manikonda Lake and its surroundings
- Spread awareness to other students in their school through poster-making competitions and by creating a “Green Wall”

Results:

- Cleaned the Manikonda Lake and its surroundings
- Partnered with Hope Foundation to reach more people in their campaign to create more green areas in cities
- Erected a “Green Wall” in their school to spread awareness to take care of life on land among younger students
