This team worked with a children's home called Sparsha Trust in Bangalore. This group of Grade 9 students worked with a wide range of stakeholders to improve the living condition and enhance the learning opportunities of the 40 students at the center. They supported the center by helping them with their technological and infrastructural issues.

#### Project Objectives:

- Ensure children at the center gain free access to technology without any restrictions
- Create a free, clean and organized environment
- Provide basic necessities for the children that will help keep their dwelling in a neat condition



#### Activities:

- Liaised with an engineer to fix all of the computers at the center
- Organized the space by the buying racks and arranging all the books and other supplies
- Provided storage facilities which helped organize the space better and made more rooms accessible to the children



#### Results:

- Got all the computers fixed at the center
- Installed racks, tables and other supplies to organize the space better
- Made the center better organized in a way that made more space available to the children



**Next Steps:** This group plans to continue working with the center for two more months to teach children about cleanliness and to monitor that all the changes they initiated is sustainable.
