This team worked on SDG 6- Clean Water and Sanitation and undertook a range of activities. They initiated the cleaning of the Manikonda Lake, they donated sanitary napkins to the Don Bosco Navjeevanam Girls Society, cleaned the premises of Bapu Ghat, and installed water purifier at their community (St. Alphonsus School).

### Project Objectives:

- Increase awareness on the importance on sanitation in their community
- Clean the Manikonda Lake
- Tackle the problem of poor menstrual hygiene

### Activities:

- Organized the cleanup of the Manikonda Lake along with the other Mission Possible teams in their school
- Donated sanitary napkins and counselled girls on the importance of menstrual hygiene at the Don Bosco Navjeevanam Girls Society
- Cleaned the premises of Bapu Ghat
- Installed water purifiers at St. Alphonsus School

### Results:

- Girls in the community are more aware about the importance of menstrual hygiene
- Children at St. Alphonsus School have access to clean drinking water
- More residents are aware and are involved in the cleanup of the Manikonda Lake
