TEAM PARIKRAMA- VIDYASHILP ACADEMY



This group worked towards supporting quality education for students at a public school using multisensory learning. They worked with the students of Parikrama Centre for Learning at Sahakarnagar, Bangalore. This school caters to orphaned and abandoned children and children belonging to households whose income is less than INR 3000 per month. They used the method of multisensory learning so the content reaches visual, auditory and kinesthetic learners. They conducted lessons on various topics in science.

Project Objectives:

- Improve learning outcomes of students by promoting interactive learning
- Make learning fun
- Ensure content reaches all students with different learning styles

Activities:

- Researched and used the method 'Multi-sensory Learning' as a scientific way to make learning fun
- Taught different topics to students using games, activity sheets, songs, play dough, etc.
- Designed activities for visual, auditory and kinesthetic learners for all content

Results:

- Increased student interest in learning
- Improved learning as assessed by multiple activities
- The majority of feedback from students shared that learning was made fun
