THE TRIPLE 'R' PROJECT - VIDYASHILP ACADEMY



This team worked with an underresourced government school to address infrastructure and spaces that were vandalized or in need of improvement. They worked towards improving the conditions of the school by installing water dispensers, donating books to the library, getting the water filtration system mended and raising awareness about health and human rights. Their goal was to support quality education by contributing to create and maintain a safe, healthy and positive learning environment for targeted school children.

Project Objectives:

- Refresh the environment in the school
- Rebuild the library of the school
- Restore the sanitary and infrastructural facilities of the school

Activities:

- Fundraised a total amount of INR 23,000 through the sale of handmade bags and a bake sale
- Provided about 700 books of different genres to the school library
- Repaired toilet doors and provided dustbins for dry and wet waste disposal
- Installed a water filter system
- Donated sports equipment for activities like cricket, basketball, badminton, football etc.

Results:

- Increased student interest in reading and made the school library more student-friendly
- Greater student awareness and openness about issues of health and hygiene
- Better facilities in the school that will lead to better health and hygiene of students

Next Steps: These Agents of Change plan to continue their engagement with the school and continue to work towards the betterment of the school
