Allocation of items

1. 
Length of statements

2. The Commission recommends a time limit of 1 minute for individual Member States and 2 minutes for delegates speaking on behalf of regional groups during the General Debate.

Unless otherwise specified, these meetings will be held from 01:30 p.m. – 06:00 p.m. on January 31; 09:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., 01:30 p.m. – 05:30 p.m., 07:00 p.m. – 09:00 p.m. on February 1; and 09:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. on February 2. In this connection, the Commission wishes to remind delegations that punctuality is of the utmost importance in the interest of ensuring an effective and orderly organization of work.

Informal Consultations

- 4. During the second informal meeting, delegates will draft resolutions in Regional Groups and then merge the differentdrafts until there is only resolution on the agenda item. After the merged draft has been prepared by the Secretariat, delegates will return to informal consultations to review the drafts line by line and propose amendments.
- 5. In accordance with established practice, informal consultations may be used for expressing general observations on the proposals The Bureau may serve as, or appoint, facilitators in order to contribute to the process of reaching consensus. If consensus if not reached on the draft resolution, it will be withdrawn.


