Organization of Work of the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice

Note by Secretariat

1. The draft organization of work of the eighth session of the WIMUN Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice, which is contained in the Annex, has been prepared in order to facilitate the Commission's consideration of the agenda item "The role of digital technologies in criminal justice systems". The provisional agenda for the session is contained in document E(WIMUN New York)/CN.15/2025/1.

Length of statements

2. The Commission recommends a time limit of 45 seconds for individual Member States and 1 minute for delegates speaking on behalf of regional groups during the General Debate.

Conference facilities and meetings arrangements

3. Taking into account the availability of conference services for the Commission, six meetings have been scheduled. Unless otherwise specified, five meetings will be held from 1:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m., on 4 February 2025; 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., 1:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m., 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. on 5 February 2025; and 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. on 6 February 2025. In this connection, the Commission wishes to remind delegations that punctuality is of the utmost importance in the interest of ensuring an effective and orderly discussion of the assigned agenda item.

Informal Consultations

4. During informal consultations, delegates will draft resolutions in Regional Groups and then merge the different drafts until there is only resolution on the agenda item. After the merged draft has been prepared by the Secretariat, delegates will return to informal consultations to review the drafts line by line and propose amendments.

5. In accordance with established practice, informal consultations may be used for expressing general observations on the proposals The Bureau may serve as, or appoint, facilitators in order to contribute to the process of reaching consensus. If consensus is not reached on the draft resolution, it will be withdrawn.

6. Bearing in mind the number of meetings scheduled for the Commission, a target date of 6 February 2025 at 12:00 pm is set for the conclusion of its work.
